

“Mollie Barnes is my name, ...”: a New England Daughter Identified

*Two Generations of Descendants of Samuel Averill
of Westminster, Plymouth & Brookfield, Vermont*

- SAMUEL AVERILL**, son of Capt. John & Mary (Phippen) Averill [*Avery, p. 301*]
1751-1759: birth, pro. in or nr. Westminster. [*age 70-79 in 1830 census; age 80-89 in 1840 census; his dau. Rebecca's death record gives his name & says he was born in Woodstock but Westminster was his parents' home & more likely correct*]
1776, ca.: marriage, firstly, to Mollie Barnes [*Avery, p. 301; birth of son Samuel, Jr., Feb. 1777; see below*]
1776, Aug. 21: pro. the Samuel Averill who enlisted as private, Capt. Elkanah Day's co., under Maj. Joab Hoisington, "residence unknown" [*Vermont Pension Certificate, cit. in Avery, pp. 301, 998*] but it must have been Westminster because this was the community from which Day's co. was drawn; this service is confirmed in "A return of the men Inlisted in a Company of which I am expected to Take the Command" drafted and signed by Elkanah Day, 1776. Samuel was enlisted on Aug. 21. If this is "our" Samuel other family members, in-laws and close associates in the company were Daniel Ranney (Aug. 8), Calvin Chaffee (Aug. 12), John Abby (Aug. 19), Joseph Phippan (Aug. 21) and Jacob Abby (Aug. 21). Aug. 21 was the last date of enlistment on this return, Aug. 8 being the first. [*Tuttle, p. 641*]
Rev. War (undated): pro. the Samuel Averill who appears on undated list of Hatch's Company of Minute men serving in Cumberland County Militia under Maj. Joab Hoisington, Capt. Joseph Hatch & Lieuts. Amos Chamberlain, Elkanah Day & Simeon Stevens [*Tuttle, pp. 833-834*]
1781, Feb. 27: 2nd marriage, to Sarah Chamberlin of Acton, First Congregational Church, Acton, Mass. [*AVR*]
1790: liv. in Westminster, Vt. as head of a family with 1 boy under 16 & 6 females [*1790C*]
1795, Nov. 30: called "my beloved son Samuel Averall" when he was bequeathed 20s. w/ the lot of land "I heretofore gave him" in his father's will [*will of John Averill, cit. in Avery, p. 187*]
1800: liv. in Plymouth, Vt. as head of a family consisting of himself, his wife, 2 girls under 10, 2 girls 10-15 & 2 girls 16-25 [*1800C*]
1802, in or aft.: 3rd marriage to Mrs. Washburn, widow of a Rev. soldier [*Avery, p. 301 where she is called his 2nd wife*]; pro. Mariah, widow of James Washburn of Woodstock, Vt. who d. 1797 [*estate settled Nov. 17, 1798; probate docs. scanned & emailed to us by Lynda Talkington, June 24, 2011; original source: Hartford District, Windsor County, Vt., Probate Records, Vol. 2, pp. 42-43, FHL film #0029160*]; identified as Maria, wife of Samuel Averill, d. bef. Aug. 17, 1830 (date of death notice), Brookfield, age 68 [*death*]

notice pub. in Danville North Star, Aug. 17, 1830]. (Ident. confirmed. See p. 18, footnote 4.) She is identified, possibly, as Mariah Fuller, dau. of Archippus & Mariah (Churchill) Fuller of Mass. [email to Bunny from Jonathan Moren, Oct. 21, 2012 who cited correspondence from a direct descendant of Mariah's step-dau. Ruth Washburn]. A descendant of Mariah herself, Sandy Howe Dean later told us of her own suspicions that Mariah's maiden name was Fuller [email to Karen, Nov. 5, 2012]. Sandy had discovered that Mariah Fuller, dau. of Archippus and Mariah, was half-sister of James Washburn's close friend Ichabod Churchill. In addition, Sandy told us that Mariah's own dau. by James (Sabra) had a dau. named Mary Churchill Howe and that Ichabod Churchill had named a son James Washburn Churchill. The identification was also put forward by John A. Maltby on his very well sourced and cited website (footnote #105). The estimated date for Samuel Averill's marriage to Mariah (Fuller) Washburn is also from Maltby's website where he states that "Mariah Washburn was mentioned as a creditor to the estate of Seth Washburn, of Woodstock, in 1802." 1820: liv. in Plymouth, Vt., farmer, w/ his wife [1820C]

1830: liv. in Brookfield, Vt., age 70-79, w/ his wife (age 60-69; pro. Mariah who d. later that yr.) [1830C]

1830, aft.: pro. m. 4thly, Sarah Coburn, sister of his son-in-law Jonas Coburn (see below under information on his dau. Hannah) [GDEC, p. 39]. Sarah Averill (dau. of Silas Coburn), d. Oct. 14, 1857, Brookfield, Vt., age 79 [VVR]

1840: pro. liv. age 80-89 in the home of his granddaughter Sarah (Coburn) Sanborn (see below under information on his dau. Hannah [1840C]

1850, bef.: death, pro. at age 96 [AA, Vol. IV, p. 200; he does not appear in the 1850 census & we can presume he d. bef. that yr.]

Samuel Averill m. 1stly, **MOLLIE BARNES**. As is shown in the accompanying article she can now be identified as the Molley Barns who was b. Apr. 9, 1755 in Groton, Middlesex Co., Mass. [GVR] She is presumed to have d. prior to her husband's remarriage in Feb. 1781. She was the mother of Samuel Averill, Jr. but cannot have been the mother of more than two, perhaps three, of the daughters. Most, if not all, of the daughters must be the children of Samuel's 2nd wife **SARAH CHAMBERLIN**.

The birth order of Samuel's daughters is unknown and the following listing is the best we can determine based on their marriage dates, ages at death, and two existing birth records. According to the number of females listed in the home of their father in Westminster in the 1790 census five of them must have been born before that date, probably in Westminster.

In the chart below, a "+" sign precedes any individual for whom a known list of descendants exists but which has not been included here as the line was outside the main thrust of our project. Because our research was focused on the identity of Samuel's wives we concentrated our efforts on researching the daughters in hopes of discovering information that would help us identify their mother.

James Gray, Jr.'s co., Vermont Militia, Col. William B. The family of Sarah (Coburn) & Moses Sanborn is very important to our research. In 1850 a Sarah Averill, age 72, born in Massachusetts was enumerated with them and she was undoubtedly the same woman, age 60-69 who had been living with them 10 years earlier in 1840. At that time there was also a male age 80-89 in the same home and this was probably Sarah Averill's husband who died at some time during the intervening decade. According to GDEC, p. 39 Sarah (Coburn) Sanborn's father Jonas Coburn had a sister Sarah, born in Chelmsford, Mass. in 1779 who married a Samuel Averill and remained childless. It is our belief that this Sarah Averill is that sister and, therefore, the aunt of Sarah (Coburn) Sanborn. The Coburn family migrated to Vermont by 1794 when their parents Silas and Esther Coburn were founding members of the First Congregational Church in Randolph.²⁶³ The record of her death in 1857 identifies her as having been the daughter of Silas. We now believe, although he was a generation her senior, that her husband was none other than the Samuel Averill who had had three previous wives, who was the grandfather of Sarah (Coburn) Sanborn and who had been thought by previous researchers to have died at age 70 in 1825. *American Ancestors*, Vol. IV, published in 1889, p. 200 states that he had died at age 96. We have collected enough evidence to believe that this was probably correct.
